Through the Last Mile Project, Youth for Christ Kenya is committed to reaching young people, **even at the ends of Kenya**.

In February alone, YFC Kenya reached out to 20,9992 students at 45 schools and almost 8,000 said yes, they want to know Jesus! What a privilege to support their work in a very practical way.



We know that what we send to support their ministry will ultimately affect the lives of thousands of young people. Teen moms who have been raped by a family member or on the way to school, given shelter, encouragement and skills training at the YFC Safe House. Kids in the slums who rake through the garbage at the side of the road to find something to eat or to sell, being encouraged that there is a way forward. Young men who are invited to be part of a soccer program instead of being lured into a gang. Young people in schools who are struggling to find any hope in the outer reaches of Kenya where they feel forgotten. YFC is coming alongside thousands of these young men and women, encouraging, expressing to them that they are seen and loved, and helping them to find
